Visiting Nonmatriculants (August 1 deadline for fall admission, January 2 for spring admission)

- Statement from applicant explaining reason(s) for requesting admission (replaces Personal essay)
- Letter of good standing from Dean's Office of degree-granting law school which also grants permission to take course work at Brooklyn Law School (Dean's Certification Form is *not* acceptable)
- Complete* official transcript from degree-granting law school

International Nonmatriculants (Foreign Trained Lawyers Program) (May 1 deadline)

(Foreign Trained Lawyers Program candidates do not need to take the LSAT or utilize the LSDAS)

- Letter of eligibility from New York State Board of Law Examiners
