

CLE Financial Aid Policy

The fees charged by Brooklyn Law School for a Continuing Legal Education (CLE) program reflect the Law School's commitment to the availability of affordable, quality CLE programs to its alumni and to members of the bar-at-large.

- Brooklyn Law School faculty and students will be admitted at no charge.
- Attorneys whose total annual income does not exceed \$50,000 <u>may be</u> eligible to receive a 50% discount.
- To apply for reduced fees for Brooklyn Law School-sponsored CLE programs, you must complete and return the Financial Aid Application Form.
