

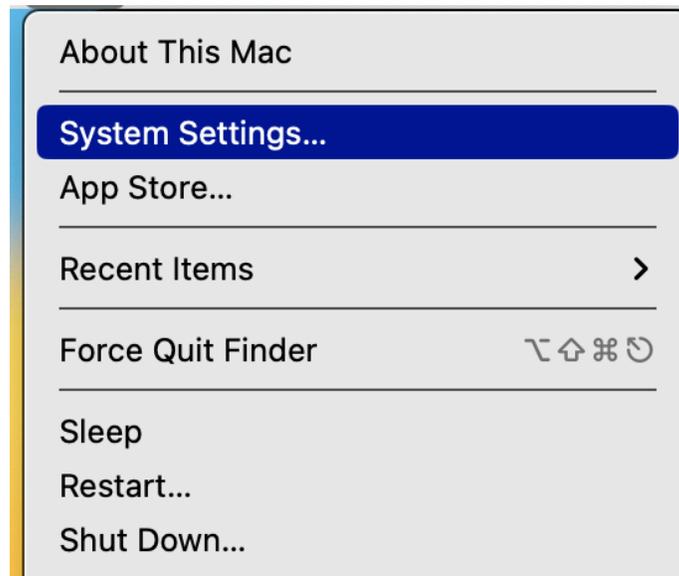
Proxy Server Instructions

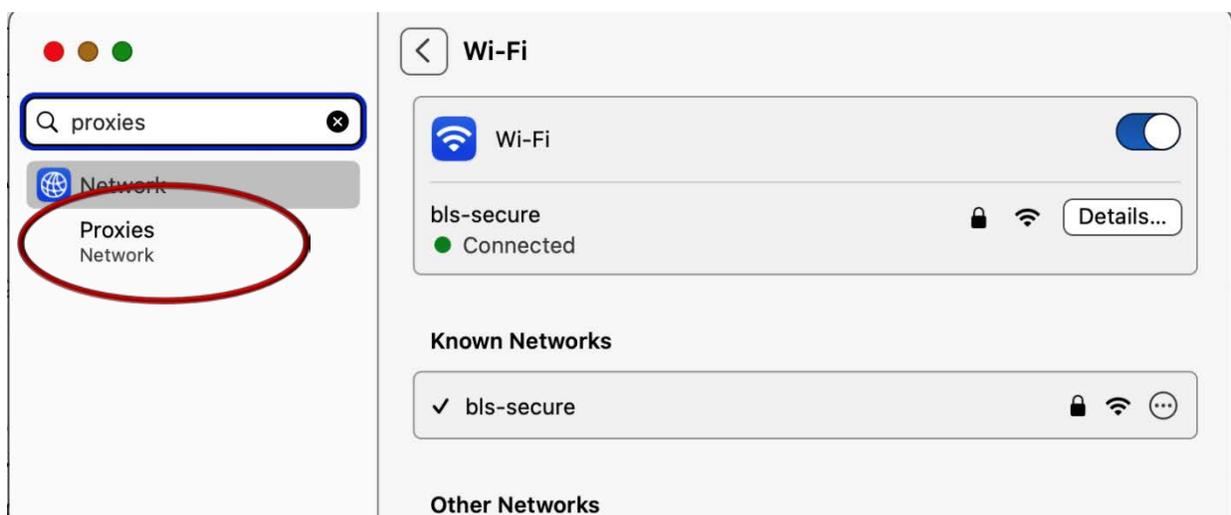

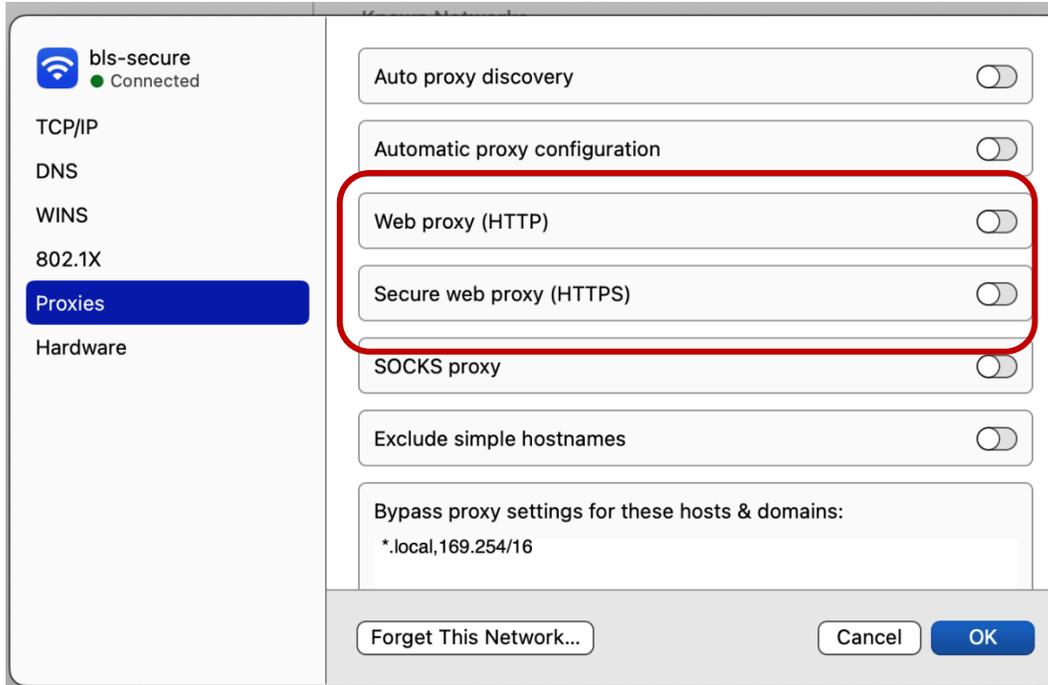
Step 1: Go to the Apple menu  at the top of the screen. Select System settings.



Step 2: Enter “proxies” in the search bar and select Proxies Network.



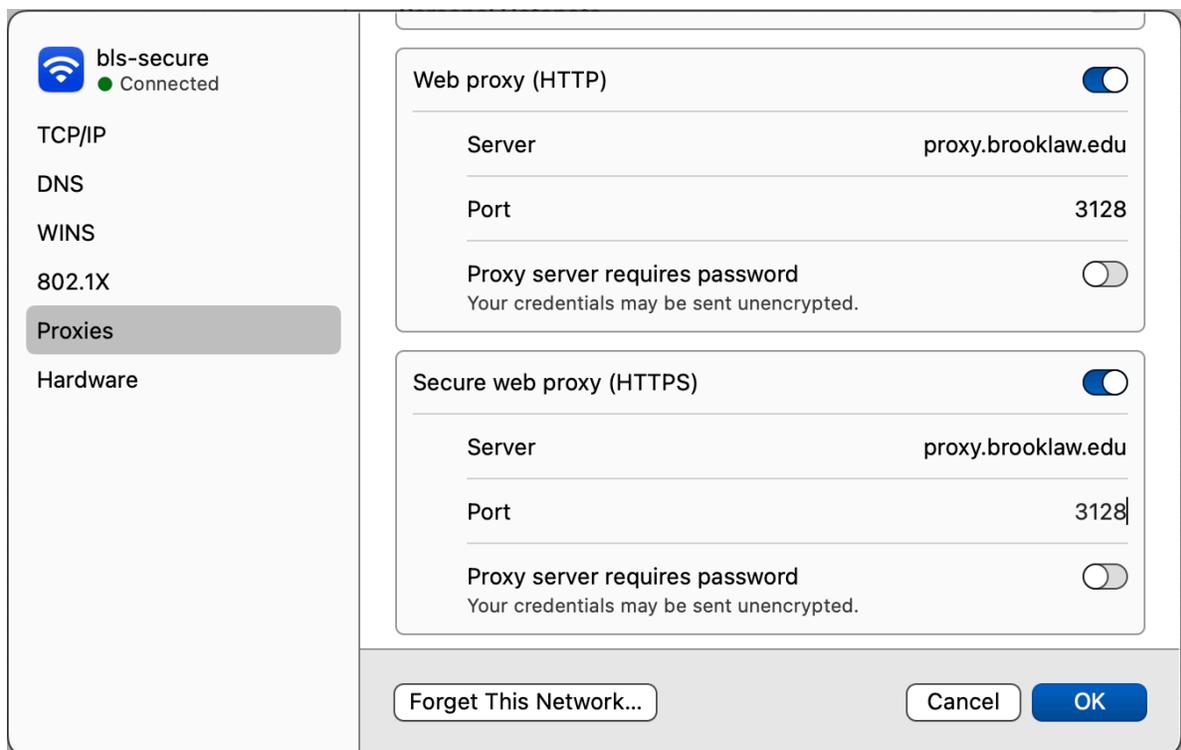
Step 3: Click on **Web proxy (HTTP)** and **Secure web proxy (HTTPS)**.



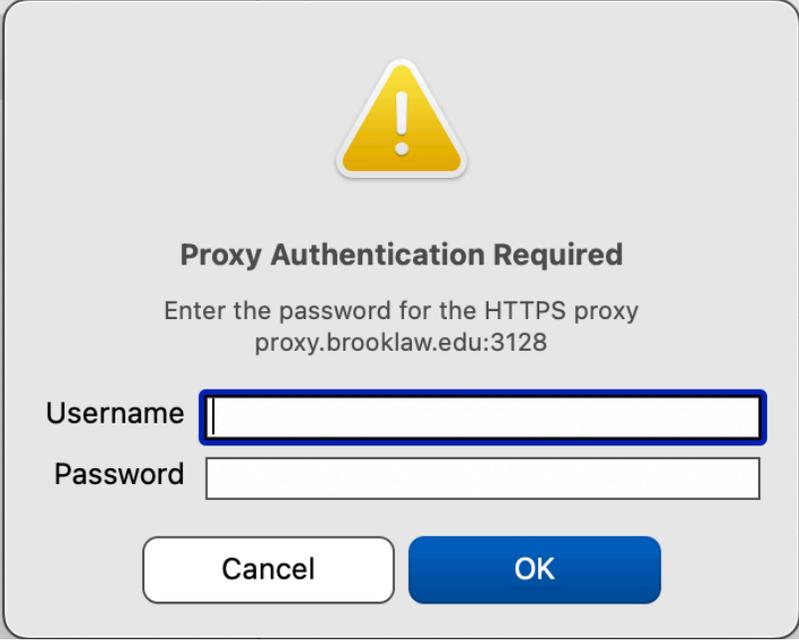
Step 4: On the Web proxy (HTTP) field under **Server**, enter “**proxy.brooklaw.edu**”. On the port field enter “**3128**”.

Step 5: On the Secure web proxy (HTTPS) field under **Server**, enter “**proxy.brooklaw.edu**”. On the port field enter “**3128**”.

Step 6: Click OK to save the settings.



Step 6. You should now be able to provide your BLS login credentials (*Firstname.Lastname*) and access BLS databases.
