Financial Aid Policy

The fees charged by Brooklyn Law School for a Continuing Legal Education (CLE) program reflect the Law School's commitment to the availability of affordable, quality CLE programs to its alumni and to members of the bar-at-large.

1. Brooklyn Law School faculty and students will be admitted at no charge.
2. Attorneys whose total annual income does not exceed \$50,000 ***may be*** eligible to receive a 50% discount.
3. To apply for reduced fees for Brooklyn Law School-sponsored CLE programs, you must complete and return the Financial Aid Application Form. You can request a copy of that form by emailing matilda.garrido@brooklaw.edu or calling 718-780-0675 no later than fifteen (15) business days prior to the date of the scheduled CLE program.
