Sparkle L. Sooknanan, Class of 2010, is an associate in the Washington, D.C. office of Jones Day in its Issues and Appeals Practice Group. During the 2013-14 term, she served as a law clerk to U.S. Supreme Court Justice Sonia Sotomayor. Sooknanan is the first Brooklyn Law School graduate to achieve this honor.

Sooknanan began her career as a law clerk to Judge Eric N. Vitaliano of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York and then clerked for Judge Guido Calabresi of the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit. She also served on the Appellate Staff of the Civil Division of the Department of Justice in Washington, D.C., where she represented the government in federal courts nationwide.

She earned the National Best Brief award at the 59th Annual New York City Bar National Moot Court Competition. She also was a research assistant to Vice Dean Dana Brakman Reiser.
