

MSCHE Required Disclosure of Third-Party Provider

Brooklyn Law School contracts with certain third-party providers to support students in preparing for the bar examination. Currently, the Law School has contracted with Themis to teach two pre-bar examination courses. The courses are taught on campus in person by Themis employees. This contract will expire in summer of 2026. Themis is a bar review service provider headquartered in Chicago, Illinois with offices in New York, NY. Themis provides services to students in-person on the Law School campus and online through synchronous instruction. The costs of these services is included in the Law School tuition and fees.

During the Spring 2026 semester, in addition to the contract with Themis, the Law School has also contracted with Barbri to teach an extended bar review course and a course on drafting for the bar. Both courses are taught in person at the Law School.

The Law School will contract exclusively with Barbri to provide bar examination preparation services beginning in August of 2026. In addition to a library of exam preparation resources, Barbri offers a credit-bearing 3L extended bar review course which is offered in person and online, asynchronously, a targeted 2L academic intervention course which is taught in person, and a pre-1L/1L online course on lawyering fundamentals which is taught online asynchronously. Barbri is the largest provider of legal learning solutions for law students. It is headquartered in Dallas, Texas, with offices in New York, NY. Barbri provides services to students in person on the Law School campus, online through asynchronous instruction, and through an electronic library of resources. The costs of these services is included in the Law School tuition and fees.
