

Visitor COVID-19 Vaccination Policies and Guidelines

Only guests with proof of a primary COVID-19 vaccination series with an <u>FDA-authorized</u> or <u>WHO-listed</u> vaccine may visit the main Law School building (250 Joralemon St.) or our high-rise residential building, Feil Hall (205 State St.). One-time visitors and guests who wish to attend in-person events are also required to provide the security guard on duty at the Law School with proof of vaccination and current identification (including your name, photo, and date of birth).

Guests Traveling from Outside the U.S.:

- As there are variations of the vaccine internationally, guests traveling from outside of the United States are required to submit proof of a primary COVID-19 vaccination series to the BLS Covid Coordinator via email at covidcoordinator@brooklaw.edu at least 10 days prior to visiting Brooklyn Law School for pre-approval.
- When submitting your vaccination information, please attach a photo or scan of your vaccination card to the email and indicate the name of the program you will be attending; the date and time of the program; your affiliation/institution; and the country you are traveling from (and, if different, where you received your vaccine). Once your information has been reviewed, we will contact you and let you know if you are approved to attend the event. One-time visitors and guests are required to provide the security guard on duty at the main Law School building (250 Joralemon St.) and Feil Hall (205 State St.) locations with proof of vaccination and current identification (including your name, photo, and date of birth).
- Mask use is optional but welcome everywhere at BLS, particularly when distance cannot be maintained, and strongly encouraged indoors when not eating or drinking. Our campus is a "mask-friendly" environment.
- Guests must sign in at the event venue and provide their contact information for contact tracing purposes.

If you are experiencing any symptoms associated with COVID-19, please do not attend this event in-person.

These requirements are based on the latest CDC guidance and are subject to change before the date of the event.
