#### Transfer Students (Advanced Standing) (August 1 deadline)

- Statement from applicant explaining reason(s) for requesting admission (*replaces* Personal Essay)
- CAS Law School Report newly-issued by LSAC (Law school-issued copy is *not* acceptable)
- Complete* official transcript from prior law school
- Letter of good standing from Dean's Office at prior law school (Dean's Certification Form is *not* acceptable)

#### Visiting Nonmatriculants (August 1 deadline for fall admission, January 2 for spring admission)

- Statement from applicant explaining reason(s) for requesting admission (*replaces* Personal Essay)
- Letter of good standing from Dean's Office of degree-granting law school which also grants permission to take course work at Brooklyn Law School (Dean's Certification Form is *not* acceptable)
- Complete* official transcript from degree-granting law school

#### Special Nonmatriculants (August 1 deadline for fall admission, January 2 for spring admission)

- Statement from applicant explaining reason(s) for requesting admission (*replaces* Personal Essay)
- Complete* official transcript from degree-granting law school
